Located in central Cambridge, in the former home of the Darwin family, with a compact, riverside site, beautiful gardens and a friendly, international community, Darwin College is the perfect place to live and work as a postgraduate student.





Living in College allows you to fully participate in the life of Darwin's diverse and welcoming community.

Darwin provides a range of accommodation options both on the College site and nearby.

We can house you for the duration of your course, and offer rooms to suit most budgets.

Whether you'd prefer to live in a single room, shared flat or studio, we'll aim to find something to meet your needs. Up to 40 rooms are offered at a rate of \pounds 130 per week or less, to provide an affordable option to students on a tight budget. These are small single rooms within centrally located buildings, with shared bathrooms.







Single rooms are available in a variety of sizes and at a range of rent levels, both with and without en-suite bathrooms.



Our off-site hostels, all within ten minutes walk of the main College site, offer spacious and character<u>ful</u> rooms, with shared kitchen facilities.

The newly acquired Causewayside building, adjoining the main site, has expanded the number of flats available to Darwin students.

These are suitable for students wishing to live with friends, or for those with partners and families.
